

Canning Town Food Bank

In response to the Covid-19 Pandemic and the needs of the local community, a new foodbank has launched in Canning Town. This is delivered by a partnership of The Canning Town Mutual Aid Group, River Christian Centre, St. Lukes Church and St. Matthias Church. The food bank has the support of and is being run in liaison with Newham Council.

REQUESTS FOR ASSISTANCE:

Can be made by any resident in the Canning Town area by calling **02074761171**. The foodbank is able to provide one care-package per household, per week. As this is run on a donation basis carepackages may be subject to availability. DONATIONS OF FOOD:

Donations of the following items can be left in the entrance area of River Christian Centre, in between the inner and outer doors. For health and safety purposes no attempt should be made to enter the centre itself when leaving a donation:

ITEMS NEEDED FOR DONATION:

- Bread
- Rice
- Flour
- Cereal
- Baby Milk
- Fresh fruit and vegetables (*ideally not close to use-by date*)
- Tinned goods (*for example fruit, vegetables, beans, tuna, rice-pudding*)
- Toiletries (*including soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toilet paper, deodorant, sanitary products, Wet wipes*)
- Pasta
- Long-life milk
- Sugar
- Biscuits and confectionery
- Nappies
