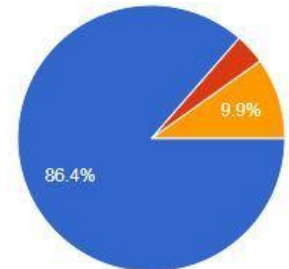

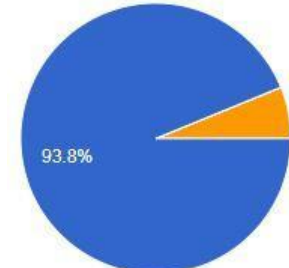

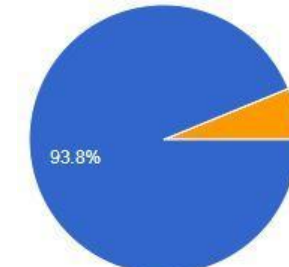
1) I was happy with the teaching and learning offered on line:



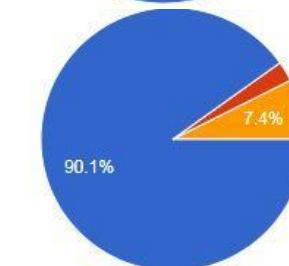
2) The school/teachers communicated well with home:



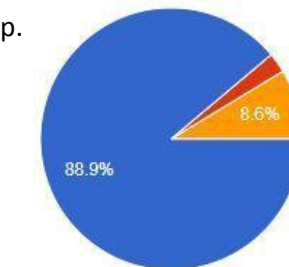
3) My family was well supported by the school to access online learning

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- Keeping children’s learning alive, amazing job done by all the teachers, even over a screen Connor got the support and attention he needed. 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- I would suggest to:
 - a) bring in more fun activities with other learning style so the kids become more engaged .
 - b) share & collaborate: curriculum to make kids virtually work with each other on the schoolwork to keep class setting collaborations.
 - c) more question to be asked from kids on the schoolwork etc. and everyone get a chance which will make to be engaged.
- Maybe increase the story time slots as all the kids loves and enjoys that. Also, why not try to do more online activities under the guidance of the teachers.
- Put more work for them, and let them interact more with the classmates. Make some games at least once a week for them to be excited to be online.
- Oak academy video lessons in afternoons were more stressful and child was unhappy to see strange faces during the lesson. It would be highly appreciated if school teachers could make themselves available for a few afternoons during the week, sort of blend of independent learning and learning with the class teachers.
- I wish there were more physical activity classes and some art/fun sessions say for example. PE is the thing they missed the most. It's just a minor thing but overall I have a positive outlook for the classes provided by school.
- Sometimes it felt like there was lot of work that needs to be done after class and by working parents, it was overwhelming at times. I really hope we don't have to go back to remote learning sessions, but I think this is one area where we might have some scope of improvement.
- Hand writing practicing book for children
- Lunch break was shorter than some other breaks which at a time was challenging.
- Only maths subject was taken every day. Please include other subjects in online teaching.

- If I have to pinpoint something it'll be to give the children more time when doing interactive work felt slightly rushed at times
- Have a itinerary for the week of what is going to be taught.
