
- Plain black jogging bottoms/shorts/leggings

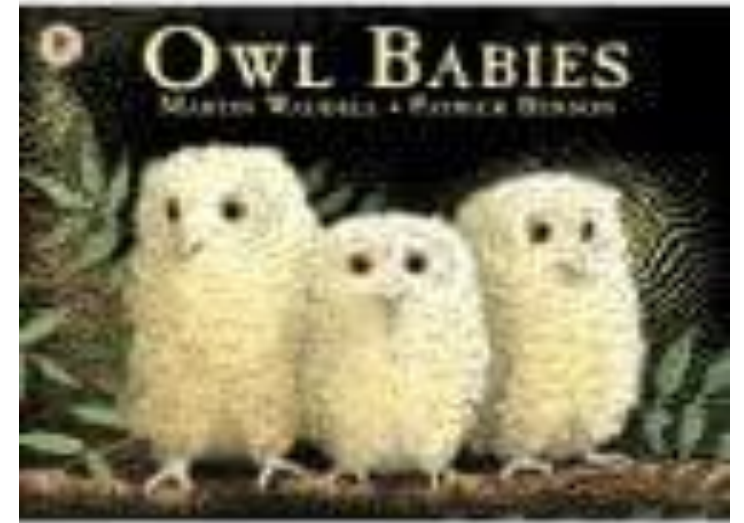
A typical day in reception– morning session
